**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101     **CONCERNING CONTINUATION OF PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE FIRE**  
102     **SERVICE TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION ADVISORY BOARD.**

**Bill Summary**

*(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)*

**Sunset Process - Senate Judiciary Committee.** Continues indefinitely the fire service training and certification advisory board (board) in the division of fire safety within the office of preparedness, security, and fire safety in the department of public safety, under the provisions of the sunset law. Continues the following, related to the board:

!       Statutory provisions describing the duties of the board;

*Dashes through the words indicate deletions from existing statute.*

- ! Statutory provisions related to education and training programs and certification programs;
- ! The firefighter and first responder certification fund;
- ! The fire service education and training fund.

Changes the statutory reference to the department of public health and environment's emergency medical services and prevention division, which no longer exists, to the emergency medical and trauma services section within the health facilities and emergency medical services division of such department.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 24-33.5-1204 (2) (c), Colorado Revised Statutes, is  
3 amended to read:

4 **24-33.5-1204. Voluntary education and training program -**  
5 **voluntary certification of firefighters - advisory board.** (2) (c) The  
6 remaining two nonvoting members shall be the president of the Colorado  
7 community college and occupational education system and the ~~director~~  
8 CHIEF of the ~~emergency medical services and prevention division~~  
9 EMERGENCY MEDICAL AND TRAUMA SERVICES SECTION within the HEALTH  
10 FACILITIES AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DIVISION IN THE  
11 department of public health and environment, or their respective  
12 designees.

13 **SECTION 2. Repeal.** 24-33.5-1209 (1), Colorado Revised  
14 Statutes, is repealed as follows:

15 **24-33.5-1209. Repeal of sections.** (1) ~~Sections 24-33.5-1204,~~  
16 ~~24-33.5-1205, 24-33.5-1206, 24-33.5-1207, and 24-33.5-1207.5,~~

8 **SECTION 4. Effective date.** This act shall take effect July 1,

10 **SECTION 5. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
12 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
