A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A LIMITATION ON THE AUTHORITY OF A FIRE
102 PROTECTION DISTRICT TO CHARGE FEES FOR PROVIDING
103 CERTAIN RESCUE SERVICES TO THOSE SERVICES PROVIDED AT
104 THE SCENE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT.

Bill Summary

A fire protection district currently has the statutory authority to set fees for ambulance or emergency medical services and extrication, rescue,

or safety services provided in furtherance of ambulance or emergency medical services. The bill specifies that the authority of the district to charge certain rescue fees is limited to services provided at the scene of a motor vehicle accident.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 32-1-1002 (1) (e) (I) (B), Colorado Revised
3 Statutes, is amended to read:

4 **32-1-1002. Fire protection districts - additional powers and**
5 **duties.** (1) In addition to the powers specified in section 32-1-1001, the
6 board of any fire protection district has the following powers for and on
7 behalf of such district:

8 (e) To fix and from time to time increase or decrease fees and
9 charges as follows, and the board may pledge such revenue for the
10 payment of any indebtedness of the district:

11 (I) For ambulance or emergency medical services and extrication,
12 rescue, or safety services provided in furtherance of ambulance or
13 emergency medical services. "Extrication, rescue, or safety services"
14 includes but is not limited to any:

15 (B) Rescue or extrication of trapped or injured parties AT THE
16 SCENE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT; and

17 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
18 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
19 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
20 11, 2010, if adjournment sine die is on May 12, 2010); except that, if a
21 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
22 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
23 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect

1 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
2 November 2010 and shall take effect on the date of the official
3 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
