ADP has a tradition of charitable giving from those attending our President's (Sales Achievers) Club. The idea is to share our good fortune by helping those in need.

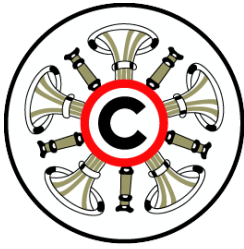
This year we have selected the Colorado State Fire Chief's Foundation in recognition of the critical importance of your need and efforts.
