The Sable Altura Fire Protection District is now accepting applications to construct an eligibility list for potential open career positions with SAFPD. Interviews and various areas of testing of qualified applicants will be conducted to build and rank personnel within this list.

The eligibility list that is created may be retained for up to one (1) year, but may be discarded entirely without any further consideration at the discretion of the Sable Altura Fire Department.

Any specific positions that are open may also have a Job Description that accompanies this announcement. Minimum qualifications for SAFD career fire personnel include but may not be limited to:

- 21 years of age
- Colorado Firefighter I or equivalent (must be IFSAC or ProBoard)
- Colorado Hazardous Materials - Operations or equivalent (must be IFSAC or ProBoard)
- Minimum of one (1) year of Firefighting/EMS experience
- Colorado Certified EMT-B (Intermediate or Paramedic preferred)

Any actual openings may require additional or higher levels of certification, and may also include different age requirements depending on the position.

Application packets for career personnel may only be obtained by email. Interested parties should send a request to careers@sablealturafire.org. Applications submitted via our website are for volunteer positions only, and will not be considered for any open career positions.

About the Sable Altura Fire Department:

The Sable Altura Fire Department is a progressive Fire/Rescue agency that lies just to the east of the city of Aurora, Colorado near E-470 and I-70. While averaging approximately 350 calls annually, the department maintains an aggressive and forward-thinking training program. The Fire District, established in 1963, is a combination department with a staff of approximately thirty-five volunteer firefighters, and four career personnel. The department apparatus is a modern fleet, and equipped with up-to-date technology and equipment. SAFD operates 9 emergency apparatus, and five command/support vehicles. SAFD provides a full-range of services with-trained and certified personnel in EMS (BLS and ALS personnel), Technical Rescue (Operations and Technician levels), and Hazardous Materials (Operation and Technician levels). The department is focused on education and training of its personnel. We are recognized by the State of Colorado's Department of Public Health and Environment EMS and Trauma Services as an EMS Training Group, as well as being a training partner with the Community College of Aurora.
