- Starting June 1st, the Westminster, Thornton & Aurora BCB locations will be promoting our "Customer Favorites" Menu as the "AJ's Fund" menu for the entire month of June. Every purchase from this menu during the month will be tracked and BCB will donate 20% of these sales to the AJ fund. We will also post a **Firefighters Special** burrito created by the different participating departments on the chalk board every week and include these sales to the AJ Fund.
- We will display banners for the participating fire departments in all three BCB stores listed above with information about the fundraiser for AJ posted throughout the stores.
- On June 27th, we will have a huge celebration at the BCB on 136th & Huron in Westminster. We will be hosting a burrito eating contest which we hope to do between members of the different fire departments. Each participating team will get certificates for Free Burritos or Free Subway Sandwiches & the winning team will get to choose a catered lunch delivered on their shift by either Subway or BCB!
 - In Addition, every customer who purchases from the AJ's Fund menu is eligible to enter the "Firefighter for a day" contest which will be announced at our big celebration on Sunday June 27th. BCB will have a fireman's boot and helmet at all stores for entries and customer donations to the Fund
