Class will be held at Loveland Fire station 1 on March 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, **0830-1630**. The course covers; Role of the Instructor, Safety, Legal Considerations, Psychology of Learning, Public Speaking, and Instructional Delivery (each student will deliver a presentation to the group).

Students are encouraged to read the IFSTA Fire and Emergency Services Instructor, **prior to class!** Students are also encouraged to bring a laptop, (not required), and their choice of fire service related topic to lecture/demonstrate to the class at the end of the second day. Examples of topics; PPE, SCBA, Hose, AED, CPR, etc., topic is up to the students.
